



Performing Arts Bursary Rules for Application

Applicants must-

1. Be less than 25 years of age on September 1st 2017.
2. Either, or both:
 - a) Live in the Osgoode ward of the city of Ottawa
 - b) Be a past or present member of the Greely Players (either onstage or backstage or in the Orchestra)
3. Be attending, been accepted for, or have applied to a Performing Arts course at a post-secondary institution. In the latter two cases, applicants must provide documented proof of acceptance with the application or as soon as possible thereafter. (Performing Arts may include music, theatre or dance or backstage skills such as sound, lights, set design, etc.)
4. Provide at least two (2) relevant **written** references and contact details of the person providing the reference.
5. Provide a c.v. indicating past achievements, including specific details of those in Performing Arts and a brief statement of why you deserve a bursary.
6. Be willing to attend a short interview if called for.
7. Submit a completed application form (available at www.greelyplayers.ca) and associated documentation, on or before June 15th, 2017 to:
